### Calculators

Students can purchase calculators through the mathematics teacher. There are two types of calculators available. *These prices may vary with supply.*

1 Casio FX-82APlus Scientific calculator. Cost \$35. This calculator meets most students' needs across all subjects.

2 Casio FX9860G111 or FX-9750G111 Graphics calculator. Cost \$135. This calculator is highly recommended for students taking an academic Mathematics course in the senior school.

A Scientific (or Graphics) calculator is essential for all senior **Chemistry and Physics** classes.
